Minutes
Wednesday, January 17, 2018

A meeting of the Sustain Libertyville Commission was held on Wednesday, January 17, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. at the Libertyville Village Hall. Those in attendance included Commission members Chairperson Doug Reed, Jerome Lukasik, Dave Wilms, Carol Cooper, Joan Sayre, Bill Cotey, and Dave Neu. Also in attendance were Deputy Village Administrator Kelly Amidei, and Cathy O'Brien, from Lake County Green Congregations.

Approval of Minutes

Joan Sayre made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 15, 2017 meeting and Carol Cooper seconded the motion. The minutes were approved by a 7-0 vote.

Green Living Fair Participation

The Lake County Green Congregations will hold the Green Living Fair on March 17, 2018 at the Civic Center. Chairperson Reed asked for volunteers to staff a Sustain Libertyville Commission booth similar to last year. Dave N., Joan and Jerry offered to assist. Last year the SLC provided a raffle item and are willing to do so again. Chairperson Reed would like to add a Committee meeting on February 21st to finalize the details for the Green Living Fair.

Noxious Plant Alternatives

Member Neu provided a list of acceptable plants that would be used to promote alternative plantings from the noxious "list". The "list" could be placed on the website to assist with educating the public about alternatives. Member Cotey asked if we would use the Green Living Fair to educate residents about the alternatives. The Commission members liked this idea and thought a two-page handout would be helpful. This can also be an item in the next Village Views newsletter.

Etech Waste Recycling

Member Lukasik explained the Green disk recycling program for recycling of VHS tapes, cds, etc. The program consists of purchasing a box to recycle the items and shipping it back once it is full. The box requires one square foot of space and is two feet high. A three-pack of boxes costs \$199.95. Member Cotey suggested working with the schools was a good way to encourage the program. The main concern was a proper location and the cost to monitor and weigh the box on a regular basis.

Goal-Setting

The 2015 Sustainability Plan needs to be updated. Deputy Administrator Amidei will send out the plan and ask that each member select one item from each category as a goal to discuss at the next meeting. Also one goal from each category of the GRC2 plan as a goal for discussion. Member Cotey asked that members consider what residents might need as they think about the goals as opposed to their personal interests.

The next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, February 21, 2018. The meeting was adjourned at 5:31 p.m.
