- 1) Approval of November 18, 2020 Meeting Minutes
A motion was made by Commissioner O'Brien and seconded by Commissioner Chynna to approve the November 18, 2020 meeting minutes with a change in wording from Agenda to Minutes in the header. The motion passed unanimously by a 6-0 roll call vote.
- 2) Additional Renewable Electrical Supply Opportunities
Chair Reed asked that additional information be provided regarding Community Solar and the ComEd Residential Supply Offer. He also asked about the Clearinghouse Solutions Community Solar for Businesses program. Administrator Amidei will check with NIMEC, the Village's municipal electric aggregation consultant, to see if they are aware of these opportunities and report at the next meeting.
- 3) Composting Developments
Administrator Amidei explained the residential composting program had begun on January 1, 2021. The program entails mixture of compost with landscape waste and the landscape waste subscription program. A handful of interested residents wanted to utilize the program but did not have the need for the landscape program. This is a new program and options will have to be reviewed with Groot in order to encourage resident involvement. Chair Reed explained the upcoming SWALCO Compost project entitled "DIG IN".
- 4) Village Views Article Review
Member O'Brien had submitted an article on recycling do's and don't's which will be included in the upcoming Spring issue. Member Wilms will provide the next article for the following issue regarding electric power sustainability.
- 5) Feedback from Related Meetings
Chair Reed reviewed and asked if any members had attended regional meetings and if there were any plans to attend any upcoming meetings.
- 6) Adjourn
Motion made by Commissioner O'Brien and seconded by Commissioner Cooper. The meeting adjourned at 4:35 pm. The next meeting is on February 17, 2021 at 4:00 pm.
