3. Bicycle Map

Staff showed the updated map to the Commission that had bicycle related signage added to the map. Staff will add the updated map to the Village website.

4. Discussion: IL Route 137 Bike Path (Independence Grove to Naval Base)

Commissioner Sallman attended the Lake County Department of Transportation (LCDOT) Open House for the (proposed) IL Route 137 Bikepath. Sallmann said that people were encouraged to draw on maps as to where they want the trail to go. Several people want the trail to be paved asphalt.

5. Other

A. Share Road Symbols: Director Kendzior informed the Commission about bike rider symbols that were painted on Northbrook roads. The bike rider symbol does not designate a bike lane but are to remind motorists and bicyclists to "share the road". In Northbrook, the bike rider symbol is a stencil that is reapplied as needed with paint by Public Works staff. The Commission likes the idea of putting these on Libertyville roads.

B. Bike Event Promotions: Trustee Pete Garrity, Commissioner Ken Glick, and ADPW Ditanto will meet with the head of the Promotions committee for Main Street to discuss Main Street's promotion of Village bicycle events such as Bike to Work and Community Bike Ride.

Lake County DOT has provided the Village with the data collected from July 2014 to January 2016.



- This user data was collected on the North Shore Trail where the trail & Fourth Avenue intersect and Route 176 & Route 41.










Fourth Street


