License and Permits Committee April 19, 2016

Minutes

A meeting of the License and Permits Committee was held on Tuesday, April 19, 2016 at 6:45 p.m. at the Libertyville Village Hall. Those in attendance included Chairperson/Trustee Jay Justice, Mayor Terry Wepler, and Village Trustees Todd Gaines and Rich Moras. Absent were Committee members Scott Adams and Pete Garrity. Others in attendance included Village Administrator Kevin J. Bowens, Police Chief Clint Herdegen, Fire Chief Rich Carani, Deputy Village Administrator Kelly Amidei, and Finance Director Patrice Sutton.


Trustee Justice moved and Mayor Wepler seconded to approve the minutes of the January 19, 2016 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Students from Libertyville High School were present to make a presentation on behalf of the Youth Advisory Board of the Lake County Underage Drinking and Drug Prevention Coalition regarding promotion of a healthy substance free lifestyle and regulation of electronic smoking devices. The Committee, Mayor, and other Trustees present all indicated their support for further regulation; however the Mayor requested that the Staff review with the Village Attorney whether or not a Non-Home Rule Community like Libertyville can adopt additional restrictions. If a determination is made that the Village can adopt additional regulations, the Committee recommended that the Village Board consider amending the Municipal Code to treat electronic smoking devices similar to cigarettes.

Lino of Lino's Ristorante at 265 Peterson Rd. was present and requested a change in his Class D License to a Class C liquor license, in order to serve liquor in addition to beer and wine. In addition, Lino indicated that he would like to periodically offer live entertainment such as a piano player. The Committee indicated their support for Lino's request, and directed him to follow-up and apply for a new license. In addition, the Committee agreed to amend the Liquor Control Ordinance and delete the current prohibition against live entertainment in any liquor license category.

The Committee meeting was adjourned at 7:08 p.m.
