

**MINUTES OF THE
VILLAGE OF LIBERTYVILLE
BOARD OF FIRE AND POLICE COMMISSIONERS
March 2, 2020**

Commissioner WEIL called to order the meeting of the Village of Libertyville Board of Fire and Police Commissioners at 4:08 PM in the ADMINISTRATIVE CONFERENCE ROOM at the Libertyville FIRE Department at 1551 N Milwaukee Avenue, Libertyville. Those present on a Roll Call were Commissioners LASKA and WEIL. Also in attendance was Fire Chief Rich Carani. Noting that the meeting had been properly noticed, and a quorum present, the Commission continued with business before it.

APPROVAL of MINUTES

Commissioner LASKA presented Minutes of the Boards 2-19-2020 meeting and moved to approve the minutes as presented. Seconded by Commissioner WEIL the motion PASSED on a UNANIMOUS Voice vote.

FIRE ENTRY LEVEL RECOMMENDATIONS

The Commission reviewed the BACKGROUND investigation performed by the Libertyville Police Department on FIRE Entry-Level Candidate CHASE L MOLL.

Based the information provided in the report, the Commission concluded that the candidate PASSED the examination. Commissioner LASKA moved to authorize a Conditional Offer of Employment be offered to the Candidate and that he be scheduled for MEDICAL and PSYCHOLOGICAL examination. Seconded by Commissioner WEIL, the motion carried on a unanimous voice vote.

POLICE ENTRY LEVEL CORRESPONDENCE

The Commission acknowledged receipt of a request by Entry-Level POLICE Candidate Michael Manolitsis to be removed from the List of Entry-Level Eligibles due to employment by another agency (HAASE e-mail 2-25-2020 1:39PM). Commissioner WEIL moved to accept the request. Seconded by Commissioner LASKA, the motion passed on a unanimous voice vote.
