

MINUTES OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
May 15, 2023

The regular meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was called to order by Chair James Hartshorne at 5:02 p.m. at 118 W. Cook Avenue.

Mr. Sandine stated he was told verbally about this policy and will check with administration.
