- 1) Approval of September 15, 2020 Meeting Minutes
A motion was made by Commissioner Cooper and seconded by Commissioner Neu to approve the September 15, 2020 meeting minutes. The motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.
- 2) Pumpkin Compost Pick-up
Chairman Reed requested 2 roll-offs from Groot for the pumpkin compost event on November 7th. The members discussed the times of the event and related signage. The Commission members discussed volunteer staffing for the event and determined a schedule. Administrator Amidei explained that the event would be shared on the Village's social media platforms and Village communications.
- 3) Native Garden
Commissioner Neu reported that the Native Garden was mostly gone. He was concerned the plants might have been pulled. In Spring it will be easier to determine what plants will return. It would be too late in this season to plant the replacements.
- 4) Future Village Views Articles
Administrator Amidei explained that the next newsletter was planned for April and Commissioner O'Brien would prepare an article on recycling by February 15, 2021. Commissioner Wilms inquired about the article he prepared on the green energy article. This can be a future article or communication piece.

5) Attainable Goals

Chairman Reed shared information about barley grass. Administrator Amidei let the members know that Commissioner Cotey was resigning due to relocating to another community. There will be a vacancy on the Commission.

6) Other Items/Updates

Chris Geiselhart shared the Audubon Society's work with Adler Arts Center for a bird scaping project. The project included the removal of dead trees and Landscape Concepts donated services for the tree removal.

Commissioner Wilms explained his research regarding solar as an energy alternative for the wastewater treatment plant.
