

MINUTES OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
August 4, 2015

The regular meeting of the Historic Preservation Commission was called to order by Chairman Hartshorne at 4:00 p.m. at Village Hall.

Members present: Chairman James Hartshorne, Robert Del Prato, Pam Hume, Mike Kollman, and Tom Wilkinson.

Discussion:

The Commission reviewed progress so far on Libertyville's SiteVista website. Commissioner Kollman suggested that we add historic photos for each property, when available. Commissioner Wilkinson suggested that we talk to Crystal Wilson about site analytics. Commissioner Del Prato asked if we can get a range of ages of properties from Ms. Wilson.

The Commission discussed consultant options for the historic survey. Commissioner Hume suggested that we consider the consultant who did the survey for Lombard. Ms. Bye stated that his name is Doug Gilbert and that she would get in touch with him. Commissioner Kollman suggested that we try one of the consultants used by Highland Park, potentially Granacki Historic Consultants. Ms. Bye stated that she would try to have proposals from consultants by the next meeting. She stated that she would also reach out to Commissioner Hamilton-Smith's recommendation, Barbara Wilcox.

It was suggested that Ms. Bye see if Jenny Barry from Cook Memorial Library can attend the next meeting to discuss resources available there.

With no further discussion, Commissioner Kollman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Wilkinson, to adjourn the Historic Preservation Commission meeting.
