

Events: There are over 50 days of events a year including, Libertyville Days, Car Fun on 21, Farmers Market, Dickens of a Holiday, David Adler Festival of the Arts and more.

Fishing: Drop your line in at Libertyville's Butler Lake or at Independence Grove.

Golf: Swing your clubs at the Libertyville Sports Complex year round driving range, or spend the day at the 9-hole Libertyville Golf Course.

Hiking/Biking: Over 8 miles of paths traverse the Village connecting to the larger Lake County path system.

Sports Facilities: Athletic fields are available for nearly every sport at numerous parks and indoors at the Libertyville Sports Complex.



Boating: Rent a boat at Independence Grove or drop your canoe and paddle down the Des Plaines River (several launches provided by the Lake County Forest Preserve District).

Parks: 500 acres of park land feature lakes, athletic fields, ice skating, flower gardens, picnic areas, and more.

Swimming: Take a dip at the pools at Adler or Riverside Parks, or jump in the lake at Lake County's Independence Grove Forest Preserve.

Winter: Cross country through Independence Grove, ski along area paths, slide down the Adler Park sledding hill, or ice skate at one of our area parks.
