2015 UNDERGROUND IMPROVEMENTS

To: **Residents of Meadow Ln**
Date: May 29, 2015

The 2015 Underground Improvement Project on Meadow Lane is nearing completion. The new 8 inch water main and new 1.5 inch home water lines are complete and are now in service. Spot repairs of the sanitary and storm sewer are 90% complete. These improvements are expected to provide many years of reliable service. We realize this work created some dirt, dust and general disruption for motorists, residents and guests. Your cooperation and patience during this important project was much appreciated.

Early next week, the sanitary sewer main line and individual sewer services will be cleaned and televised. Televising sewer lines is important to verify that no damage was done during water main installation and that completed sewer repairs are acceptable. During the cleaning operation, it is possible for homeowners to hear gurgling noises from toilets or floor drains especially in lower levels of your home. In some cases toilets or floor drains may discharge dirty water. To prevent this from occurring, it is recommended to cover lower level drains & toilets with an old towel or plastic during sewer cleaning. The work will generally take place between 8am & 2pm, Monday, June 1 and/or Tuesday, June 2. Please feel free to call one of the phone numbers noted below for specific times related to your address.

As you are likely aware, street rehabilitation is the next phase of work. This project will include curb replacement, full depth pavement patching, grinding, asphalt resurfacing and finally landscape restoration. Curb replacement is expected to begin mid-June and will be followed by remaining work. Unfortunately during this phase of work, dirt, dust, noise and some inconvenience cannot be avoided. Village staff, our consultant and the contractor will do everything possible to keep you informed and minimize inconvenience.
