

Libertyville Solid Waste and Recycling Program



We are pleased to provide the residents of Libertyville with an updated guide for the collection of residential refuse, recycling and yard waste. Residents now have an expanded recycling program with an option to upgrade the size of your recycling cart at no additional charge.

To register for the larger 95 gallon recycling cart please email us at Libertyville@groot.com by December 18, 2015. Please provide your name, address and phone number. Recycling carts will be switched out by January 31, 2016



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VILLAGE OF LIBERTYVILLE RESIDENTIAL REFUSE, RECYCLING & YARD WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES (RATES EFFECTIVE 06/01/2015 TO 05/31/2016)



Included in the refuse program the residents of Libertyville will have access to the following:

1. Unlimited Standard Refuse Service: Service includes weekly collection of unlimited household garbage with a 95-gallon cart. One bulk item (non-appliance) will be collected each week for no additional charge. Refuse is required to be out by 7:00 a.m. each week. The monthly charge for this service is \$25.88.

2. Limited Refuse Service: Service includes the weekly collection limited to one 95-gallon cart and one bulk item per week. Additional refuse found outside the cart will require one prepaid refuse sticker to be affixed to each container or bag not to exceed 33-gallons. The price for this service is \$19.70 per month. An additional 95-gallon cart with collection will be an extra \$5.00 per month.



3. Pay-Per-Bag Refuse Program: Service requires that one prepaid refuse sticker be affixed to each container or bag not to exceed 33-gallons put out for weekly collection. Each container or bag is not to exceed 50 pounds.

Refuse stickers may be purchased for \$3.07 each. The required minimum level of recycling service provides a 65-gallon cart at \$5.62 per month. Please note, if you generate more than one bag of refuse per week, the standard level of service will be more cost effective.

Senior Program: To receive the senior discount residents must be 65 years old or older. Service will include weekly limited collection of one 95-gallon cart for refuse, and one 65-gallon cart for recycling. Seniors must be registered with the Village for the water bill discount in order to be eligible for the senior garbage rate of \$17.73 per month.

Recycling: Please note, the refuse programs mentioned above include a 65-gallon cart for recycling. New to the Libertyville program, residents will have an option to upgrade to a 95-gallon cart for recycling. We are asking residents to contact Groot directly by December 18, 2015 via email at Libertyville@groot.com for this upgrade. Groot will deliver new carts to those that have requested them by January 31, 2016. Please note if you do NOT want to upgrade the size of your cart there is no reason to contact us. A complete list of recyclable items can be found within this brochure.

Appliances: White goods such as refrigerators, ovens, window and central air conditioners, humidifiers, dryers, water heaters, dishwashers, furnaces, etc. require a special pick-up and separate disposal required by state law. A \$25.00 fee is charged per item for collection. Residents must call and schedule a pick-up in advance.

Holidays Observed:

New Year's Day	Memorial Day

If the Holiday falls on a Sunday, Monday will be an off day with service delayed one day the remainder of the week.



Landscape Waste (Rates through 12/31/2016): Residents have three options for yard waste collection:

1. Landscape Waste Stickers: Residents who have limited volumes of yard waste will have the option to purchase a sticker in which to affix on either a biodegradable yard waste can or bag not exceeding 33-gallons. Stickers will be available for \$2.25 each at the following locations:

2. Landscape Waste Subscription Service: Residents who generate higher volumes of yard waste will have the option to sign-up for the subscription program. The program allows up to 6 biodegradable bags or cans not exceeding 33-gallons of yard waste per week from April 1st through October 14th. Between October 15th and November 30th, 12 biodegradable bags or cans not exceeding 33-gallons per week are able to be set out for collection. To receive this service resident's must call Groot and subscribe for the 2015 season in the amount of \$130.00.



Tree limbs, branches or brush must be cut to no more than 4 feet in length, bundled no greater than 1 foot in diameter and not to exceed 50 pounds each.

3. Abbreviated Seasonal Subscription Service: Between October 15th and November 30th, up to 12 biodegradable bags or cans not exceeding 33-gallons will be collected weekly. The cost for this service is \$45.00 for the 2015 season.

Bulk Item Disposal: Service includes collection of one (1) bulk item (non-appliance) per week at no additional cost. For additional bulk items, residents should call Groot to schedule a pick-up and make payment arrangements.

Bulk items include: boxes, barrels, crates, furniture, and similar items that do not fit into a proper container and can be collected/lifted by one driver without assistance. Exceptions include items which are banned from direct disposal into a landfill.

Oversized, Overweight Items and Construction Demolition Debris: Any single large or extra heavy item that requires us to schedule a special pick-up to remove will require a special quote from Groot. Residents are required to call and schedule a pick-up in advance. Examples of an oversized item are a large screen television, piano or any item that requires two people to lift.

Construction Demolition Debris: All material must be cut to no more than 4 feet in length and no larger than 2 feet in diameter. All debris must be bagged or bundled not exceeding 50 pounds. Residents need to call Groot to obtain price quote and to schedule pick-up.

E-Waste Collection: Certain electronic items are prohibited from being disposed of in Illinois landfills. Groot will collect, at the curb, up to six electronic items for \$30.00 (excluding televisions). Televisions (not to exceed 50 pounds) will be collected for a prepaid fee of \$50.00 each. Requests for service must be made 24 hours in advance of your service day. Call us at 877-404-7668 to schedule the collection of e-waste.

PAPER

- Office/School Paper
- Newspaper
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Glossy & Non-glossy Inserts
- Shredded paper bagged in clear plastic bag
- Telephone Directories
- Advertising/Junk Mail
- Kraft Paper Bags
- Cardboard
- Paperboard/Chipboard
- Books (No leather cover books)
- Soda & Beer Carrying Cases
- No Metal Clips, Spirals or Binding
- Shredded paper must be bagged



PLASTIC

All plastic bottles and containers with these symbols underneath.



- #1 PETE – Beverage containers both clear and colored.
- #2 HDPE – Natural beverage containers. Colored detergent/health care containers.
- #3 PVC – Food, health care/beauty aid and household containers.
- #4 LDPE – Various food containers.
- #5 PP – Various food containers.
- #7 Other – Narrow neck containers and buckets up to 5 gallons.

Rinsed Juice/Milk Cartons
(Aseptic Containers)

METAL/GLASS

Aluminum, steel and tin cans
Clean brown, green and clear glass

ALL MATERIALS CAN BE MIXED TOGETHER

DO NOT: FOR THE LOVE OF RECYCLING

- **DO NOT** include mirrors, light bulbs, window glass or ceramics in recycling container.
- **DO NOT** include soiled paper fibers (oily pizza boxes, paper napkins, etc.).
- **DO NOT** include medical waste.
- **DO NOT** place materials in plastic bags.
- **DO NOT** include Styrofoam, wood, plastic film, or diapers.
- **DO NOT** recycle batteries
