Re: **2016 Street Improvements Project**
Streets: Florsheim Drive, Kempton Drive

Dear Resident:

You may be aware of the bond issue approved in 2012's referendum to repair Village roads. We are pleased to advise you that your street will be rehabilitated and resurfaced as part of the Village's 2016 Program. A contract for this work was awarded to A-Lamp Concrete Contractors of Schaumburg.

The roadway rehabilitation work includes replacing curb and gutter, adding storm sewer, milling the edge of the existing concrete pavement, and resurfacing. There will also be extensive concrete patching of the existing roadway, and some drainage structures along the curb line will be repaired. Disturbed parkways and driveways will be restored after paving work is completed.

In order to expedite the pavement patching and provide a safe environment for residents and traffic, the patching portion of the project will be divided into two phases (see attached exhibit):

PHASE 1: Close the east side of Kempton Dr, and the south side of Florsheim Dr.

One-Way Traffic Only allowed Southbound on Kempton Dr. and Westbound on Florsheim Dr.

PHASE 2: Close the west side of Kempton Dr. and the north side of Florsheim Dr.

One-Way Traffic Only allowed Eastbound on Florsheim Dr. and Northbound on Kempton Dr.

Note: For both phases, Two-Way Traffic will be maintained on Florsheim Dr. between the Spring Meadows main entrance and Artaius Pkwy.

We anticipate construction work beginning as early as next week in your area, and you will soon see the utility location markings (paint and flags) in preparation for the work. Please do not disturb these markings as they provide important guidance for the contractor and show the location of existing underground utilities. We will provide you with more information on the schedule as soon as it is available.

If curb and gutter is being replaced in front of your driveway apron, be advised that you will be without the use of your driveway for approximately one week. You will receive a **hand-delivered** notice to your front door in advance of any necessary driveway closure with further information.

If you are temporarily out of your driveway, please note the following:

- During working hours, please park away from those areas where the contractor is working; this will expedite their operations, and also minimizes the chance for inadvertent damage to vehicles. After-hours and overnight, you should be able to park closer to home.
- Please do not park within 50 feet of an intersection corner or a stop sign, and at least 25 feet from any fire hydrant.

We understand that the upcoming construction work will create inconvenience for all affected residents and will do our best to minimize the disruptions. Your patience and cooperation is greatly appreciated.

HOW TO OBTAIN CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

A. VILLAGE OF LIBERTYVILLE DIRECT PHONE NOTIFICATION


