understand the rules of lacrosse, active teamwork, sportsmanship, and foster personal development in a respectful environment led by positive coaching. IGLA has adopted the US Lacrosse "PLAYERS FIRST" ATHLETE DEVELOPMENT MODEL which means smaller fields and a smaller number of players. Kids are more engaged, get more touches on the ball, and further develop their skills. **Location: Deerpath Park, 299 Onwentsia Rd, Vernon Hills, IL 60061**

In the spring, IGLA offers two levels of league play: Pink and Purple. Both are recreational, community lacrosse. Pink teams practice once a week. Purple teams practice twice a week and may travel more for games. If considering Purple, players must attend an assessment where participants are assessed on stick skills and game play.
