

## HIGHLANDS SUBDIVISION FLOOD REDUCTION PROJECT

**Subject: Highlands Subdivision Flood Reduction Project  
Notice of Open House & Start of Construction**

Dear Resident,

The Village of Libertyville is excited to announce the start of construction of Phase 2 of the Highlands Subdivision Flood Reduction Project located near your property. Phase 2 includes construction of large storm sewers along Drake, Dawes, Carter, Burdick, Ames, Austin, Ash Rockland, Harms, Shari and Dymond Road (s). The storm sewers will be directed into the newly constructed flood control storage basin in Nicholas Dowden Park on the south side of Crane Boulevard. The work will be limited to the Village right of way and all efforts will be made to accommodate traffic accordingly. The intent of Phase 2 of the Highlands Subdivision Flood Reduction Project is to reduce flooding throughout the subdivision. This area experiences chronic street flooding, and sometimes even structure flooding, during heavy rainfall events. This important project was outlined in the recently completed Master Stormwater Management Plan ([www.libertyville.com/stormwaterplan](http://www.libertyville.com/stormwaterplan)).

**An open house will be held Wednesday March 22, 2023, from 4 PM to 6 PM at the Village of Libertyville Village Hall, located at 118 W Cook Avenue** to discuss the project in more detail. All are invited to come and learn more about the Highlands Subdivision Flood Reduction Project.

DiMeo Bros, Inc. was awarded the contract for this work and will serve as the general contractor. The project is anticipated to begin on, or about **April 3, 2023**, with the conclusion of storm sewer work and roadway paving in **November 2023**.
